## New Gov't Initiative to Reduce Business Creation to 10 Days

PORT-AU-PRINCE, Haiti (defend.ht) – The Minister of Trade and Industry (MCI), Wilson Laleau launched on Tuesday a modernization project to reduce from 105 days to 10 days the registration of limited companies in Haiti.

At the event Minister Laleau criticized the position of Haiti in the latest “Doing Business Review” of the International Finance Corporation (IFC), where Haiti lost eight spots in the rankings over the past year.

This modernization project is a first in the history of Haitian public administration, part of the program of “E-governance” introduced by the executive.

President Michel Martelly attended the event and spoke pledging his full support for the realization of the project. Martelly insists that this initiative will aid in facilitating investment and creating jobs in Haiti.
